### **Fall Heirloom Plant Sale at the Hermitage, September 26th**

Norfolk, VA - The fourth annual [Fall Heirloom Plant Sale](#) will be held on Saturday, September 26th from 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. Museum members will receive a 10% discount throughout the day. The sale will feature perennials, shrubs, native and wetland plants, and several other heirloom plants that grow well in the Tidewater area.

Fall is the best time to plant small trees, shrubs, and hardy perennials. The mild temperature allows roots to establish and strengthen before winter dormancy.

Plants available at the sale will include Agapanthus, Aster, Beautyberry, Blue Mist Flower, Camellia, Chaste Tree, Daphne, Daylily, Feather Reed Grass, Fern, Gardenia, Hydrangea, Iris, Lavender, Leopard Plant, Rose Mallow, Sweet Pepper Bush, Wax Myrtle and many more!
